We are now in Stage-2.0 of the university's shelter-in place and the safety of our staff and imagers continues to be our first priority.

During this time an increased number of researchers can begin working again. Each CSIF area/room has a posted max occupancy to meet the University's safe working density. The CSIF microscope's online iLab reservation calendars have been modified to reflect the need not to exceed the established room occupancy limits.

For Stage 2 all users of the CSIF must be listed as Essential Personnel in their PI's SmartSheets and, prior to beginning work, have completed the STARS COVID-19 Hygiene Best Practices training course:
